## • Financial Report

Our deficit is running higher than predicted (\$11,800), partially due to some unanticipated expenses ytd, lower than anticipated envelop givings and user group donations. It is expected that the year end deficit will be in the 4K range. Discussion is ongoing as to how we will finance that debt. We will continue to monitor our current financial picture and share this information with you.
